### We provide a safe environment

We maintain a safe and secure environment by providing cages or kennel spaces for each pet. Dogs are let out to one of four yards and may only play and interact with other dogs/cats from there same household. Cats are in a separate part of kennel and are only allowed to play with cats/dogs from there households.

### Food and Meds

Each pet is taken care of a minimum of 3 times per day during the week and a minimum of twice a day on the weekends, at this time pets will be give their food and meds according to instruction the Owner / Dr. provides.

### Dr on call during business hrs!

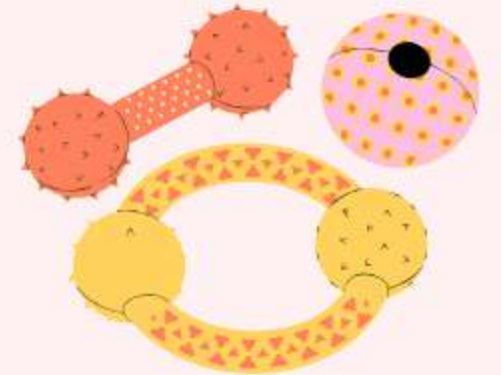

### Play Times

Afraid your pet won't get enough interaction with humans while you are gone? Feel free to add on daily play times for your pet to ensure they get the cuddles and human interactions that they deserve! Please keep in mind play times are only done on days that the hospital and kennel are open.

## Potty Times

Have a new puppy or an old dog? Afraid they will have accidents in their cages? Fear not we offer a standard 3 potty times during the week and 2 potty times on the weekend. Not enough for your furry friend? Opt for adding an extra potty time per day to help keep dog and cage clean while you are away. Please keep in mind extra potty times are only done on days that the hospital and kennel are open.

If you'd like your pet to go home feeling a little extra special, you can opt for the kennel bath / kennel nail trim. The kennel staff will happily bathe your dog, or do a nail trim if given enough time to provide these services during your pet's stay.
